Water sample bottles and requisition forms are available at the Sproat Lake Community Hall, as well as Tseshaht Market, and Dellas Café during business hours from June 28th to July 8th, 2024. Water samples should be taken on Monday morning, July 8th, and delivered



with the completed requisition form and \$75 payment (to SLCA) to the Sproat Lake Community Hall between 9 am and 11 am for transport to the testing facility in Courtney.
